

KUHN EXTENDS GYROTEDDER RANGE WITH NEW MODELS FOR SMALLER FARMS

PALMERSTON NORTH – (7 July 2010) The Kuhn range of Rotary tedders is growing with the arrival of three new "low-end" models for farmers looking for machines which will provide high quality work, while being reliable yet available at "low" cost.



The three-point mounted Gyrotedders GF 422, GF 502 and GF 642 fit the bill, with working widths of 4.20 m (4 rotors), 5.00 m (4 rotors) and 6.40 m (6 rotors) respectively. This extends the Gyrotedder range to include working widths from 4.2 to 17.0 metres.

Series 102 GF Rotary tedders are equipped with an oblique drive via manual wheel steering, used for close-cutting or distributing grass upwards on slopes.

The new models all feature Kuhn's patented DIGIDRIVE® rotor drive, which with its world-renowned reliability, requires very little maintenance and makes this machine very compact for transport.



To ensure good load-bearing capacity and good quality tedding, GF 102 rotors are all equipped with balloon tyres with an optimal angle of attack which is factory preset. The rotors each have six tine arms and are also equipped with "pro" tines (four coils, large diameter and different prong lengths) to optimise fodder collection quality. The GF 642 is also equipped as standard with a lateral stabiliser, for perfectly controlled work on slopes and bumpy ground.

Automatic recentering during hydraulic vertical folding of the outer rotors during transport helps provide safety and operational comfort for the farmer.
