

FERTILISER SPREADER AXIS 20.1 W – Precision in mixed farming as well as in breeding

PALMERSTON NORTH – (13 April 2011) A weighing system on a fertilizer spreader allows the user to control the fertilizer application rates while spreading and to make savings.

Widely renowned and used in cereal producing areas, this weighing system is now offered by KUHN on the AXIS 20.1, intended for mixed farming- breeding farms.

The continuous regulation of the weighing system is recognized for its simplicity, its spreading quality and precision. The AXIS weighing system indicates the quantity of fertilizer remaining in the hopper and features an «Online» regulation.

The «Online» regulation analyses continuously the fertilizer flow and corrects the outlet openings every second. As from the first spreading meters, the AXIS weighing system makes instantaneous adjustments, no calibration test or spreading of a minimum dose is required before spreading.

Designs intended to make the AXIS 20.1 W very user-friendly

The AXIS 20.1 W is fitted with the latest «CDA System» technology, innovative distribution to meet current and future fertilization requirements. The working width is adjustable in just a few seconds by modifying the fertilizer drop point without removing or adjusting a pallet.

A patented device, the outlet guide, guides the fertilizer to the disc, preventing any dispersal of the product to spread when coming into contact with the pallets. The agitator rotates at 17 rpm in order not to damage the granules.

The discs are removed in a few minutes without tools. There are no discs seizing on the hubs.

The AXIS 20.1 W is supplied ready to use and is fitted as standard with the TELIMAT border system, rear lighting, a speed sensor and a connection cable to the tractor ISO 11786 plug to obtain the forward speed.

The AXIS 20.1 W offers a working width of 12 to 28 m and a capacity of 1000 to 2300 litres.
